The Parish

The Catholic Church offers to every member the benefits of Mass and the Sacraments, numerous opportunities for private devotion, prayer groups, and public liturgy, and a variety of parish ministries such as sacramental preparation, faith formation, and service to those in need.

Because of the combined stewardship of all the parishes, many more services are made available through the Archdiocese. Among them Circle Lake Retreat Center, Catholic Charities, Youth Ministry, Marriage Tribunal, Engaged Encounter, San José Clinic, The Education of Seminarians, and support for the initiatives of our Holy Father and our United States Bishops.

Discipleship calls us to more than membership; it calls us to an active stewardship. To support all these ministries, we need your active stewardship in this parish. No more and no less is asked of Catholic school parents and students than of any parishioner. What does stewardship ask of parish members, including students?

- **Make a lifelong commitment to practice stewardship as a way of life.**
- **Participate in Mass on Sunday and Holy Days.**
- **Practice the faith in the workplace, the home, the classroom, and in civic life.**
- **Support and cooperate with the religious education program of the parish:** adult faith formation, Catholic school, CCE, sacramental preparation, RCIA, etc.
- **Participate in parish ministries, activities, and organizations through your contributions of time and talent.**
- **Support the ministries of the Catholic Church by pledging and tithing sacrificially to the parish** (with a goal of 8 percent of family income to the parish and 2 percent to other charities of your choice).
- **When budgeting, make your tithe from your first fruits given to God.**

If a family is unable to meet its 15-hour service obligation, the family must pay for the remaining hours at the rate of \$20 per hour.
